6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to vehicle operator's  
7 licenses; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 28.15.030(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) who has not attained the age of 16 years  
12 [, EXCEPT THAT THE DEPARTMENT MAY ~~ISSUE~~ A RESTRICTIVE  
13 OPERATOR'S LICENSE TO A PERSON WHO IS AT LEAST 14 YEARS OF  
14 AGE];

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 28.15.040(a) is amended to read:

16 (a) A person who is at least 16 [14] years of age may  
17 apply to the department for an instruction permit. After  
18 the applicant successfully completes all parts of the  
19 examination except the driving test, the department shall  
20 issue an instruction permit which entitles the applicant  
21 while having the permit in his immediate possession to drive  
22 a motor vehicle upon the public highways for a period of  
23 six months [60 DAYS] when accompanied by an adult licensed  
24 operator who has at least one year of driving experience and  
25 who is occupying a seat beside the driver, except when the  
26 permittee is operating a motorcycle. An instruction permit  
27 may be renewed or a new permit issued upon application to  
28 the department [FOR ONE ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF 90 DAYS].

1       \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
2 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
