6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to vehicle operator's
7 licenses; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.030(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) who has not attained the age of 16 years,
12 except that the department may issue a restrictive operator's
13 license to a person who is at least 14 years of age upon
14 proof that the applicant requires the use of a motor vehicle
15 for gainful employment and the license is limited to use
16 solely for that purpose; [EXCEPT THAT THE DEPARTMENT MAY
17 ISSUE A RESTRICTIVE OPERATOR'S LICENSE TO A PERSON WHO IS
18 AT LEAST 14 YEARS OF AGE;]

19 * Sec. 2. AS 28.15.040(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) A person who is at least 16 [14] years of age may
21 apply to the department for an instruction permit. After
22 the applicant successfully completes all parts of the
23 examination except the driving test, the department shall
24 issue an instruction permit which entitles the applicant
25 while having the permit in his immediate possession to drive
26 a motor vehicle upon the public highways for a period of
27 six months [60 DAYS] when accompanied by an adult licensed
28 operator who has at least one year of driving experience and
29 who is occupying a seat beside the driver except when the

permittee is operating a motorcycle. An instruction permit may be renewed or a new permit issued upon application to the department [FOR ONE ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF 90 DAYS].

* Sec. 3. AS 28.15.040(d) is repealed.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
