6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to vehicle operator's
7 licenses; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 28.15.040(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) A person who is at least 14 years of age may apply
12 to the department for an instruction permit. After the appli-
13 cant successfully completes all parts of the examination
14 except the driving test, the department shall issue an
15 instruction permit which entitles the applicant while having
16 the permit in his immediate possession to drive a motor
17 vehicle upon the public highways for a period of one year
18 [60 DAYS] when accompanied by an adult licensed operator who
19 has at least one year of driving experience and who is
20 occupying a seat beside the driver except when the permittee
21 is operating a motorcycle. An instruction permit may be
22 renewed or a new permit issued upon application to the
23 department [FOR ONE ADDITIONAL PERIOD OF 90 DAYS].

24 * Sec. 2. AS 28.15.040(d) is amended to read:

25 (d) The department may issue a special operator's
26 permit to a person who is at least 14 [13] years of age
27 with the consent of his parents or guardians for the purpose
28 of operating a motor scooter or motor bicycle upon the
29 highways. This permit shall be issued upon application and

1 payment of the prescribed fee and is valid for the same
2 period of time as an operator's license.

3 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
4 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
