BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 15.20.130 is amended to read:

Sec. 15.20.130. PROCEDURE ON APPLICATION BY MAIL.

After [UPON] receipt of an application by mail for an ab-
sentee ballot, the secretary of state, or the district or
deputy magistrate, shall [IMMEDIATELY] airmail to the appli-
cant the ballot and other absentee voting material when they
are ready for distribution [TO THE APPLICANT], if the appli-
cation includes the name and both the present address and
the full local resident address of the applicant. The
larger envelope to be used for returning the absentee ballot
to the election officials shall be addressed to the election
supervisor in the district in which the voter is a resident.
