6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to increase the number of superior
7 court judges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. It is the intent of this Act that a superior
10 court judge sit at Sitka.

11 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.120 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 22.10.120. NUMBER OF JUDGES. The superior court
13 consists of ten [NINE] judges, three [TWO] of whom shall be
14 judges in the first judicial district, one of whom shall be
15 judge in the second judicial district, four of whom shall be
16 judges in the third judicial district, and two of whom shall
17 be judges in the fourth judicial district. At the time of
18 submitting the names of nominees to the governor to fill a
19 vacancy on the superior court bench, the judicial council
20 shall also designate the district in which the appointee is
21 to first reside and serve.
