6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the reporting of money,  
7 goods and services received by candidates  
8 for nomination and election."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 15.55 is amended by adding a new section to  
11 read:

12 Sec. 15.55.25. REPORTING OF CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS. (a)

13 A candidate for nomination for or election to a state office  
14 must report in writing on the last day of each month during  
15 the year in which he is a candidate for office the source and  
16 monetary value of all money, goods and services received by  
17 or made available to him by individuals, firms, or committees.  
18 A candidate for legislative office reports to the district  
19 attorney of the district in which he resides. A candidate for  
20 state-wide office reports to the attorney general. The  
21 attorney general devises the reporting form.

22 (b) All persons, committees, organizations and groups  
23 supporting a candidate or group of candidates for nomination  
24 or election must report by the end of each month all funds,  
25 goods or the value of services expended or utilized in support  
26 of a candidate or group of candidates. Reports are made to  
27 the district attorney of the district in which it operates  
28 unless it operates in more than one district or on a state-  
29 wide basis. In the latter case it reports to the attorney

1 general on forms devised by him. The person, committee,  
2 organization or group shall submit a final report to the  
3 proper officer by February 1 of the year following the  
4 general election.

5 (c) All news media operating under business licenses  
6 issued by the state are to report on August 1, November 1,  
7 and December 1 of even-numbered years the amount of money  
8 received on behalf of each candidate or ticket of candidates  
9 for nomination and for election to state office. The report  
10 is to be made to the attorney general on forms devised by  
11 him.

12 (d) Any person found to be in violation of the obli-  
13 gation to report or failing to report fully and accurately  
14 is guilty of a felony.
