14 is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one year,
15 or by a fine of not more than \$500, or by both.
16 * Sec. 2. AS 11.20.590(d) is amended to read:
17 (d) A person who wilfully violates [SEC. 580 OF THIS
18 CHAPTER OR] a subsection of this section is guilty of a
19 misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of
20 not more than \$500, or by imprisonment in jail for not more
21 than one year, or by both.
