6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to penalties for violation
7 of the law relating to the control of liquor
8 manufacture and traffic; and providing for
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 04.10.010 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 04.10.010. CONTROL OF LIQUOR MANUFACTURE AND
13 TRAFFIC. No person, firm, corporation, or ganization, or
14 company may manufacture, sell, offer for sale or possess for
15 sale or barter, traffic in, barter or exchange for goods in
16 this state, an intoxicating liquor without first procuring an
17 appropriate license. This section does not apply to sales
18 made by a person under the provisions of law requiring him
19 to sell personal property. A person who violates this section
20 is guilty of a felony and upon conviction is punishable by
21 imprisonment for not less than one year, nor more than five
22 years.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 04.15.100(a) is amended to read:

24 (a) A person who violates any provision of this title
25 other than sec. 80 of this chapter or AS 04.10.010 is guilty
26 of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by im-
27 prisonment of not more than one year, or by a fine of not
28 more than \$500. Each violation is a separate offense.

29 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage

1 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
