6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the payment of child
7 support by imposition of automatic payroll
8 deductions."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 09.55.210(2) is amended to read:

11 (2) for the payment from the party in fault, not
12 allowed the care and custody of the children, an amount of
13 money, in gross or installments, as may be just and proper
14 for that party to contribute toward the nurture and education
15 of the children, and the court may, order the party to arrange
16 with his or her employer for an automatic payroll deduction
17 each month or each pay period, if the period is other than
18 monthly, of the amount of the installment. If the employer
19 agrees, the installment is forwarded by the employer to the
20 clerk of the superior court which entered the judgment or the
21 court trustee and the amount of the installment is exempt
22 from execution;
