6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to residence requirements
7 for fishing and hunting; and providing
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 16.05.940(14) is amended to read:

11 (14) "resident" means a person who for 12 con-
12 secutive months immediately preceding application for
13 license has maintained a permanent place of abode in, and has
14 been domiciled in the state and who has continually maintained
15 his voting residence in the state, and; in the case of a
16 partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, or
17 corporation, "resident" means one that has its main office or
18 headquarters in the state; however, a member of the military
19 service who has been stationed in the state for the preceding
20 12 consecutive months is a resident for the purposes of this
21 chapter, and the dependent of a resident member of the
22 military service, who has been living in the state for the
23 preceding year is a resident for the purposes of this chap-
24 ter, and a person who is an alien but who for three years has
25 maintained a permanent place of abode in the state is a
26 resident for the purposes of this chapter, except that an
27 alien who for one year immediately preceding his application
28 for a license has maintained a permanent place of abode in
29 the state is a resident for purposes of sport fishing;
