6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the inclusion of
7 employees of the Pioneers' Home in the
8 classified service; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 47.25.010(c) is amended to read:

12 (d) [(C)] The office of the governor [MAY EMPLOY THE
13 NECESSARY SUBORDINATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES, AND] shall
14 prescribemethods for operation of the Pioneers' Home,
15 standards of care and service to inmates [, AND RULES
16 GOVERNING PERSONNEL AND REWARDING EMPLOYEES ON A MERIT
17 BASIS]. All employees of the Pioneers' Home are within
18 the classified service under AS 39.25. An employee of the
19 Pioneers' Home who held his position on January 1, 1966,
20 may be continued in his position without examination if he
21 meets the minimum qualifications for his position and if
22 he has been in state service for at least six months. An
23 employee who does not meet the minimum qualifications for
24 his position is subject to examination under AS 39.25 and
25 the rules adopted under that chapter.

26 * Sec. 2. AS 39.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

27 Sec. 39.25.125. PIONEER HOME EMPLOYEES EXCLUDED FROM
28 PARTIALLY EXEMPT SERVICE. The employees of the Pioneers'
29 Home are not considered to be employees of the office of the
