6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend the definition of the
7 practice of hairdressing and beauty
8 culture."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.28.320(10) is amended to read:

11 (10) "practice of hairdressing and beauty culture"
12 is engaging, for compensation or other reward, in any of the
13 following practices: (A) arranging, dressing, curling,
14 waving, cleansing, singeing, bleaching, coloring, or simialr
15 work on a wig or hair piece of artificial or human hair or
16 upon the hair of a living person by any means; (B) trimming
17 women's hair, as a part of women's hairdressing; (C)
18 utilizing cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions,
19 or creams, with the hands or with a mechanical or electrical
20 apparatus, in massaging, cleansing, stimulating, manipulat-
21 ing, exercising, or beautifying the scalp, face, neck, arms,
22 hands, bust, or upper part of the body of a person, for the
23 purpose of beautification;
