6 For an Act entitled: "An Act to amend the definition of the
7 practice of hairdressing and beauty
8 culture."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 08.28.320(10) is amended to read:

11 (10) "practice of hairdressing and beauty culture"
12 is engaging, for compensation or other reward, in any of the
13 following practices: (A) arranging, dressing, curling,
14 waving, cleansing, singeing, bleaching, coloring, or similar
15 work on a wig or hair piece of artificial or human hair ,
16 including a man's toupee, or upon the hair of a living person
17 by any means; (B) trimming women's hair, as a part of women's
18 hairdressing; (C) utilizing cosmetic preparations, anti-
19 septics, tonics, lotions, or creams, with the hands or with
20 a mechanical or electrical apparatus, in massaging, cleansing,
21 stimulating, manipulating, exercising, or beautifying the
22 scalp, face, neck, arms, hands, bust, or upper part of the
23 body of a person, for the purpose of beautification;
