6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the designation and
7 support of historical sites and monuments."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 CHAPTER 25. HISTORICAL SITES AND MONUMENTS.

11 Sec. 38.25.010. DESIGNATION OF SITES AND MONUMENTS.

12 The governor may designate any natural formation, site,
13 building, marker, graveyard and the land which appertains to
14 it as an official historical site or monument of the state if
15 it is owned by the state and if it is privately owned, it may
16 be so designated with the written consent of the owner or
17 owners.

18 Sec. 38.25.020. FINANCIAL SUPPORT AND CONTROL. State-
19 owned historical sites and monuments owned or purchased by
20 the state are under the control of the department of natural
21 resources and their maintenance shall be covered in the ap-
22 propriations made to that department. Privately owned
23 historical sites and monuments are eligible to receive state
24 support for the maintenance of the site or monument if it is
25 kept accessible to the general public and application for
26 partial support is made in conformity with regulations
27 promulgated by the commissioner of natural resources.
