6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the classification of
7 lands for homestead entry; and providing for
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 38.05.325 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 38.05.325. HOMESTEAD ENTRY. The director, with
12 the approval of the commissioner, may authorize homestead
13 entry on lands not under grazing lease or otherwise appropri-
14 ated and which are classified as agricultural lands or [AND]
15 grazing lands, if they are not school lands, mental health
16 lands or lands conveyed to the state by the federal govern-
17 ment for the specific purpose of producing revenue.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 38.05.365(2) is amended to read:

19 (2) "agricultural lands" [AND "GRAZING LANDS"]
20 means [MEAN] lands chiefly valuable for agricultural [OR
21 GRAZING] purposes;

22 * Sec. 3. AS 38.05.365 is amended by adding a new subsection
23 to read:

24 (21) "grazing lands" means lands chiefly valuable
25 for grazing purposes.

26 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
