6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the minimum salary scale  
7 for teachers; and providing for an effective  
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.220 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 14.20.220. MINIMUM TEACHERS' SALARY SCALE BY AREA  
12 [SENATE DISTRICT]. (a) The school board of each school  
13 district in the Southeastern area [SENATE DISTRICT] shall pay  
14 a regularly qualified teacher employed by it a salary not  
15 less than that set out in this subsection.

16 (1) The base salary of a teacher with three years'  
17 training is \$5,000 [\$4,750] for a teacher with no public  
18 school experience in the state. The salary is augmented by  
19 \$200 [\$150] for each year of public school experience in the  
20 state up to and including four years.

21 (2) The base salary for a teacher holding a  
22 bachelor's degree and having the requisite number of hours in  
23 education is \$6,000 [\$5,500]. This salary is augmented by  
24 the sum of .04 times the base for each year of public school  
25 experience in the state up to and including eight years.

26 (3) The base salary for a teacher having a master's  
27 degree and the required number of hours of education is  
28 \$6,500 [\$6,000]. This salary is augmented by the sum of .04  
29 times the base for each year of teaching experience in the

1 state up to and including 12 years.

2 (b) The school board of each school district in the  
3 Southcentral area [SENATE DISTRICT] shall pay the amount set  
4 out in (a) of this section plus \$200 [\$400].

5 (c) The school board of each school district in the  
6 Central area [AND NORTHWEST SENATE DISTRICTS] and that part  
7 of the Southcentral area [SENATE DISTRICT] lying west of 152°  
8 West Longitude shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this  
9 section plus \$400 [\$700].

10 (d) The department, as the operating agency of schools  
11 outside school districts, shall pay a regularly qualified  
12 teacher employed by the state a salary of not less than \$500  
13 a year above the salary set out in (a), (b), [AND] (c), and  
14 (f) of this section.

15 (e) Not more than four years of public school experi-  
16 ence outside the state may be substituted for a like period  
17 of public school experience in the state when a teacher's  
18 position on the salary scale is established.

19 (f) The school board of each school district in the  
20 Northwest area shall pay the amount set out in (a) of this  
21 section plus \$700.

23 Sec. 14.20.230. SUPERINTENDENTS' SALARIES. The school  
24 boards of school districts and the department as the operat-  
25 ing agency for schools outside school districts shall pay a  
26 regularly qualified superintendent a salary not less than the  
27 allowable base for his position on the teacher's scale pro-  
28 vided in sec. 220(a) - (f) [(a), (b), (c), (d), AND (e)] of  
29 this chapter, plus

1 (1) 20 per cent of the base for a superintendent  
2 of a district or state school with an average daily member-  
3 ship of less than 500;

4 (2) 25 per cent of the base for a superintendent  
5 of a district or state school with an average daily member-  
6 ship of 500 or more.

8 Sec. 14.20.240. SALARIES OF PRINCIPALS AND VICE  
9 PRINCIPALS. The school boards of school districts and the  
10 department as the operating agency for schools outside  
11 districts shall pay each regularly qualified principal and  
12 vice principal a salary not less than the allowable base for  
13 his position on the teachers' scale provided in sec. 220(a) -  
14 (f) [(a), (b), (c), (d), AND (e)] of this chapter, plus

15 (1) 15 per cent of the base for a principal;

16 (2) 10 per cent of the base for a vice principal.

18 Sec. 14.20.245. SALARIES OF OTHER ADMINISTRATORS. The  
19 school boards of school districts and the department as the  
20 operating agency for schools outside districts shall pay a  
21 regularly qualified administrator for whom certification is  
22 required, other than a superintendent, assistant superintend-  
23 ent, principal, or vice principal, a salary not less than the  
24 allowable base for his position on the teachers' scale pro-  
25 vided in sec. 220(a) - (f) [(c)] of this chapter plus 15 per  
26 cent of the base.

(2) "Northwest area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 17, 18, and 19;

(3) "Southcentral area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12;

(4) "Southeastern area" means that area included within the boundaries of election districts 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.
