7 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to pay increments for
8 State employees assigned to remote
9 locations; and providing for an effective
10 date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 39.27 is amended by adding a new section to
13 read:

14 Sec. 39.27.020. PAY INCREMENTS IN REMOTE LOCATIONS.

15 The following pay increments are approved under AS 39.25.
16 150(2) as an amendment to the pay plan for employees of
17 the state.

18 (1) Permanent employees assigned to permanent
19 duty stations at locations more than one hundred miles
20 from the Ketchikan, Juneau, Anchorage, or Fairbanks city
21 boundary and which are accessible to one of the above
22 cities by road, railroad, or ferry shall be paid at a
23 rate three percent above the pay provided by sec. .010
24 of this chapter.

25 (2) Permanent employees assigned to permanent
26 duty stations at locations which are not accessible to
27 Ketchikan, Juneau, Anchorage, or Fairbanks by road, railroad,
28 or ferry shall be paid at a rate six percent above the
29 pay provided by sec. .010 of this chapter.

(3) The commissioner of administration shall

promulgate regulations designating permanent duty stations
which are eligible for pay increments under this section.
* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 16, 1966.
