6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring that a person be a candidate  
7 for only one office in a primary election;  
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 15.25.030 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 15.25.030. REQUIREMENTS OF DECLARATION OF PARTY  
12 CANDIDACY. A member of a political party who seeks to be-  
13 come a candidate of the party in the primary nomination shall  
14 execute and file a declaration of candidacy. The declaration  
15 shall be executed under oath before an officer authorized to  
16 take acknowledgments and shall state in substance: (1) the  
17 full name of the candidate and the manner in which he wishes  
18 his name to appear on the ballot; (2) the full resident  
19 address of the candidate; (3) the full mailing address of  
20 the candidate; (4) if the candidacy is for the office of  
21 state senator or state representative, the election or senate  
22 district of which the candidate is a resident; (5) the  
23 office for which the candidate seeks nomination; (6) the  
24 name of the political party of which he is a candidate for  
25 nomination; (7) the date of the primary nomination at which  
26 the candidate declares himself to be a candidate; (8) that  
27 the candidate meets the specific residency requirements of the  
28 office for which he is a candidate; (9) that the candidate  
29 will meet the specific citizenship requirements of the office

1 for which he is a candidate; (10) that the candidate is a  
2 qualified voter as required by law; (11) that the candidate  
3 will meet the specific age requirements of the office for  
4 which he is a candidate; (12) that the candidate if nomi-  
5 nated and elected will support the principles of the party  
6 he seeks to represent; (13) that the candidate requests that  
7 his name be placed on the party primary nomination ballot;  
8 [AND] (14) that the required fee accompanies the declaration;  
9 and (15) that he is not a candidate for any other office to  
10 be voted upon at the primary nomination.

11 \* Sec. 2. This Act applies to the primary nomination of 1966  
12 and to declarations of candidacy filed therefor.

13 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage  
14 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
