7 maintenance of state automotive equipment by
8 the department of public works."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.43.020 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 44.43.020. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT

12 The Department of Public Works is charged with (1) the duties
13 involved in the construction, maintenance, and operation of
14 state ferries, airports, docks, floats, breakwaters,
15 buildings, and similar facilities; and (2) the supervision
16 and maintenance of all state automotive equipment, aircraft
17 and vessels except vessels used by the Department of Fish and
18 Game.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 44.44.020 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 44.44.020. GENERAL POWERS AND DUTIES OF DEPARTMENT

21 The Department of Highways is charged with (1) the duties
22 involved on the construction, maintenance, and operation of
23 state highways, roads, bridges, traffic signs and signals,
24 and other like facilities; and (2) the supervision and
25 maintenance of all state [AUTOMOTIVE AND] mechanical equip-
26 ment excluding aircraft and vessels.

28 Sec. 44.74.010. WORKING CAPITAL FUND. A working capital
