6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the power of first class
7 and home rule cities and organized boroughs
8 to punish for ordinance violations."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 29.10.195(a) is amended to read:

11 (a) The council may prescribe the punishment for the
12 violation of any ordinance, but the punishment shall not
13 exceed a fine of \$300 or imprisonment in a city jail for 30
14 days, or both, together with the costs of prosecution. How-
15 ever, the punishment authorized under this subsection may be
16 imposed only if the ordinance is codified and copies of it
17 are made available to the public.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 29.08 is amended by adding a new section to read:

19 ARTICLE 2. GENERAL POWERS.
20 Sec. 29.08.200. LIMIT ON HOME RULE POWER TO PUNISH
21 ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS. A home rule city may not impose
22 criminal penalties for the violation of an ordinance unless
23 the ordinance is codified and copies of it are made available
24 to the public.
