6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the unlawful discharge of
7 weapons; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.55 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 Sec. 11.55.065. UNLAWFUL DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS. Any
12 person who discharges a firearm within the state and who is
13 not shooting at legal game or at a target, having a suitable
14 backstop, which was especially erected for the purpose of
15 target shooting is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon con-
16 viction is punishable by imprisonment for not more than one
17 year, or by a fine of not more than \$500, or by both. In
18 addition to the imposition of a term of imprisonment or a
19 fine which may be imposed under this section, the court shall,
20 upon conviction, confiscate and retain in its possession any
21 firearm discharged in violation of this section.

22 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
23 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
