6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making the solicitation of certain
7 political contributions a misdemeanor."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.70 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 Sec. 11.70.040. UNLAWFUL SOLICITATION OF POLITICAL
12 CONTRIBUTIONS. (a) No person may solicit a political
13 contribution

14 (1) from a person who he knows is an employee in
15 the state service;

16 (2) from an owner, officer or employee of a
17 company which he knows has a contract of business with the
18 state; or

19 (3) while inside a public building.

20 (b) In this section

21 (1) "employee in the state service" means a
22 person employed in one of the positions specified in AS 39.25.
23 100, 39.25.110 and 39.25.120;

24 (2) "political contribution" means any money to
25 be used for the support of a political party or candidate in
26 a partisan election;

27 (3) "public building" means a building in which
28 governmental services are rendered and which is owned by, or
29 leased to, an agency, department or governing body of the

state or any of its political subdivisions, whether home rule or otherwise.

(c) A person who violates a provision of this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both.
