6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the requirements for
7 teacher certification."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.20.020 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 14.20.020. REQUIREMENTS FOR ISSUANCE. (a) The
11 department shall issue a teacher's certificate to every
12 person who meets the requirements in (b) of this section.

13 (b) To be eligible for a teacher's certificate a
14 person shall

15 (1) hold at least a baccalaureate degree from a
16 college or university approved by the National Council for
17 the Accreditation of Teacher Education, the North Central
18 Association, or the Northwest Association;

19 (2) possess a statement from the governing body
20 of the college or university from which he obtained his
21 degree certifying the subjects and levels in which he is
22 adequately prepared to teach;

23 (3) have successfully performed as a student
24 teacher in a program which is under the direction of personnel
25 acceptable to the department, and which meets such other
26 standards for a student teaching program as the department
27 may prescribe by regulation.

28 (c) The requirements of (b) of this section are not
29 applicable to persons employed in the state public school

(d) The department shall insure that the certificate issued authorizes teaching only in those subjects and levels in which it has been certified that the person is adequately prepared according to (b)(2) of this section.

(e) There shall be no requirements for certification other than those prescribed by (b) of this section.
