6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Judicial Council; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 30. THE JUDICIAL COUNCIL.

11 Sec. 22.30.010. MEMBERSHIP. The membership of the  
12 Judicial Council shall be as provided for in sec. 8, art. III,  
13 Constitution of the State of Alaska.

14 Sec. 22.30.020. DUTIES. In addition to the powers and  
15 duties of the council described in the constitution and  
16 implemented by this title the council shall:

17 (1) adopt rules for the conduct of its business;

18 (2) meet at least four times each year;

19 (3) hire and direct the activities of a profes-  
20 sional clerical staff required to assist it in carrying out  
21 its duties;

22 (4) conduct studies for the improvement of the  
23 administration of justice;

24 (5) make reports and recommendations to the  
25 supreme court and the legislature at intervals of not more  
26 than two years.

27 Sec. 22.30.030. TRAVEL AND PER DIEM. Members of the  
28 council, other than the chairman, are entitled to the travel  
29 and per diem allowances authorized members of boards and

commissions under general law for attendance at meetings or other authorized activities of the council.

Sec. 22.30.040. APPROPRIATIONS. The council shall submit its request for appropriations to support its activities during each fiscal year through the chief justice of the supreme court for inclusion in the court system's budget request to the legislature.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1966.
