6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing state aid to municipi-
7 palities for municipal airport projects."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 02.15.120 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 02.15.120. ASSISTANCE TO CONSTRUCT, ENLARGE OR
11 IMPROVE AIR NAVIGATION FACILITIES. (a) The department
12 may match available funds with those of municipalities,
13 federal agencies or other state agencies, for the purpose of
14 assisting to construct, enlarge or improve airports. The
15 department may assist persons in the construction, enlarge-
16 ment and improvement of airports and air navigation facili-
17 ties. The airports and facilities, until they are abandoned
18 as such, shall be at all times available for the use of and
19 accessible to the general public, and maintained as public
20 airports and facilities.

21 (b) A municipality otherwise authorized by law to
22 establish airports is eligible to receive state aid for
23 construction, enlargement or improvement of airports in an
24 amount equal to 75 per cent of project costs excluding the
25 amount of funds available to the municipality for the
26 project under the Federal Aid Airport Program or any other
27 public or private source.

28 (c) In order to qualify for the state aid authorized
29 under (b) of this section, the applicant municipality shall

1 submit and have approved by the commissioner plans, programs,
2 contracts or agreements for implementation of the municipal
3 airport construction, improvement or enlargement and shall
4 appropriate 25 per cent of project costs excluding the
5 amount of funds available to the municipality for the project
6 under the Federal Aid Airport Program or any other public
7 or private source. Upon approval of an application, the
8 commissioner shall transmit to the municipality the amount
9 of state aid for which it qualifies.

10 (d) The commissioner shall by regulation require reports
11 from municipalities to which state aid has been transmitted
12 under the provisions of (b) of this section. The reports
13 shall include data on all funds expended for project costs
14 and shall be required during project execution and at the
15 time of project completion. The commissioner may by regula-
16 tion prescribe other requirements governing administration of
17 the state aid airport program authorized by this section.
