6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to veterinarians; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.98.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.98.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD.

11 There is a Board of Veterinary [VETERINARIAN] Examiners.

12 It consists of three licensed veterinarians.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 08.98.210 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

14 Sec. 08.98.210. OUT-OF-STATE VETERINARIAN. An

15 applicant who has engaged in practice as a licensed vet-
16 erinarian in a state, territory, district, or possession
17 of the United States may be licensed without written
18 examination if

19 (1) he meets the qualifications of sec. 170
20 of this chapter;

21 (2) he has been engaged in licensed practice for
22 five out of the previous seven years prior to filing his
23 application;

24 (3) he first passes an oral examination by the
25 board; and

26 (4) the jurisdiction in which he holds his most
27 recent valid license extends the same privilege to those
28 holding a license from this state.

29 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
