6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sports contests; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 05.10.120 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 05.10.120. ANNUAL LICENSES TO PARTICIPANTS. (a)

11 The commission may grant annual licenses upon application in
12 compliance with the rules and regulations prescribed by the
13 commission and the payment of the fees prescribed for
14 manager, referees, examining physicians, boxers, wrestlers,
15 seconds, [AND] trainers, timekeepers and umpires.

16 (b) The following is the schedule of annual fees:

17 (1) examining physicians, \$10;

18 (2) managers, \$50;

19 (3) referees, \$10;

20 (4) seconds, \$10;

21 (5) trainers, \$10;

22 (6) boxers, \$10;

23 (7) wrestlers, \$10;

24 (8) timekeepers, \$10;

25 (9) umpires, \$10.

26 (c) This section does not apply to contestants and
27 other [OR] participants in strictly amateur contests
28 sponsored by [OR] fraternal or federally chartered veterans'
29 organizations [OR VETERANS' ORGANIZATIONS CHARTERED BY

1 CONGRESS OR A FEDERAL DEPARTMENT OR A BONA FIDE ATHLETIC
2 CLUB] holding and promoting amateur athletic contests if the
3 proceeds [OR SMOKERS WHERE ALL FUNDS] are used exclusively
4 [PRIMARILY] for the benefit of a recognized charity and for
5 necessary and reasonable expenses incurred in holding the
6 contest [THEIR MEMBERS].

7 (d) The annual license may be revoked by the commis-
8 sion for cause under the Administrative Procedure Act
9 (AS 44.62).

10 (e) The commission shall designate the referee for the
11 contest from among licensed referees.

12 (f) No person may participate or serve in any of the
13 above capacities unless licensed as provided in this chapter.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 05.05.030(b) is amended to read:

15 (b) Nothing in this chapter gives the commissioner or
16 the commission jurisdiction over the athletes or athletic
17 programs of any elementary or high school or a college or
18 university. The jurisdiction of the commissioner or the
19 commission does not extend to amateur athletic events held
20 under the auspices of a bona fide fraternal, veterans or
21 civic organization as sanctioned and governed by the regula-
22 tions of a recognized national amateur athletic organization.

23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
24 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
