6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for benefits to workmen  
7 suffering permanent total disability under  
8 the Alaska Workmen's Compensation Act; and  
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 23.30.175(b) is amended to read:

12 (b) In computing compensation for permanent total  
13 disability the average weekly wages are considered to have  
14 been not more than \$100 [\$81]. If the average weekly wages  
15 as computed under sec. 220 of this chapter are less than \$25  
16 [\$18] a week he shall receive as compensation for permanent  
17 total disability his average weekly wages.

18 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1966.
