6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the provisions of the  
7 borough law relating to the relationship  
8 between the schools and the borough; and  
9 providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 07.15.330(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) Each organized borough constitutes a borough school  
13 district and the first and second class borough shall estab-  
14 lish, maintain, and operate a system of public schools on an  
15 areawide basis [, AND SHALL DO SO IN THE MANNER PROVIDED BY  
16 LAW FOR CITY SCHOOL DISTRICTS, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED  
17 IN THIS TITLE].

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 07.15.330(d) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

19 (d) The school board shall submit the annual budget  
20 for the following school year to the assembly by April 1 for  
21 approval of the total amount. Within 30 days after receipt  
22 of the budget the assembly shall determine the total amount  
23 of money to be made available from local sources for school  
24 purposes, and shall furnish the school board with a statement  
25 of the sum to be made available. If the assembly does not,  
26 within 30 days, furnish the school board with a statement of  
27 the sum to be made available, the amount requested in the  
28 budget is automatically approved. Not later than May 31, the  
29 assembly shall appropriate the amount to be made available

1 from local sources from municipal money available for the  
2 purpose.

3 \* Sec. 3. AS 07.15.330(e) is amended to read:

4 (e) The assembly [BOROUGH] shall determine the location  
5 of school buildings with due consideration of the recommenda-  
6 tions of the borough school board.

7 \* Sec. 4. AS 07.15.330(f) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

8 (f) The school board is responsible for the design  
9 criteria of school buildings. Subject to the approval of  
10 the assembly, the school board shall select the appropriate  
11 professional personnel to develop the designs. The school  
12 board shall submit preliminary and subsequent designs for a  
13 school building to the assembly for approval or disapproval.  
14 If the design is disapproved, a revised design shall be  
15 prepared and presented to the assembly.

16 \* Sec. 5. AS 07.15.330(g) is amended to read:

17 (g) The borough school board shall provide custodial  
18 services and routine maintenance for school buildings and  
19 shall appoint, compensate, and otherwise control personnel  
20 for these purposes. [THE SCHOOL BOARD SHALL APPOINT, COMPEN-  
21 SATE, AND OTHERWISE CONTROL ALL SCHOOL EMPLOYEES AND ADMINIS-  
22 TRATIVE OFFICERS.] The borough chairman shall provide for  
23 all major rehabilitation, all construction, and major repair  
24 of school buildings. The recommendations of the school board  
25 shall be considered in carrying out the provisions of this  
26 subsection.

27 \* Sec. 6. AS 07.15.330 is amended by adding a new subsection  
28 to read:

29 (j) The school board is responsible for the appointment,

1 compensation, and control of all school employees and adminis-  
2 trative officers in accordance with AS 14.

3 \* Sec. 7. AS 07.30.020(c) is amended to read:

4 (c) The date of the regular election for the school  
5 board is the same as that for the council in the largest  
6 first class city within the borough or annually on the first  
7 Tuesday of October if there is no first class city within  
8 the borough. The term of office for a member of the school  
9 board begins on the first Monday following certification of  
10 the results of the election.

11 \* Sec. 8. This Act takes effect July 1, 1966.
