6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the use of firearms;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.15 is amended by adding a new section to
10 read:

11 Sec. 11.15.205. FAILURE TO USE ORDINARY CARE WITH
12 FIREARMS. (a) A person who, as a result of his failure to
13 use ordinary care under the circumstances, wounds another
14 person with a bullet or shot from a firearm is punishable,
15 upon conviction, by a fine of not more than \$1,000, or
16 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both. In
17 addition, a person may be prohibited by the court from
18 using or obtaining any license to hunt for a period not to
19 exceed 10 years.

20 (b) A person who, as a result of his failure to use
21 ordinary care under the circumstances, injures personal
22 property belonging to another with a bullet or shot from a
23 firearm is punishable, upon conviction, by a fine of not
24 more than \$100, or imprisonment for not more than 10 days,
25 or by both.

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage
27 and approval or on the day it becomes law without such approval.
