5 Relating to the construction and
6 maintenance of roadside camps.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
8 CURRING:

9 WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of all Alaskans and all
10 travelers in the state that well-equipped and well-maintained
11 roadside campgrounds be provided in the state; and

12 WHEREAS, at the present time there is an insufficient number
13 of roadside campgrounds; and

14 WHEREAS, the campgrounds are not being adequately main-
15 tained;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioner of Natural Resources is
17 requested to institute a crash program to provide additional
18 campgrounds, particularly in the interior regions of the state;
19 and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Commissioner of Natural Resources
21 assume the responsibility for the maintenance of the campgrounds
22 in the state; and be it

23 FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to
24 the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska, and to the
25 Honorable Phil Holdsworth, Commissioner of Natural Resources.
