4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Directing the legislative council
6 to study and report on the office
7 space needs of state agencies.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the housing of state agencies at the capital and
11 throughout the state has been a continuing problem which is over-
12 due for solution; and

13 WHEREAS the space problems faced by the smaller territorial
14 government have been compounded by the expanded needs of state
15 government; and

16 WHEREAS the efficient and economical operation of the state
17 government is adversely affected by the lack of adequate space
18 designed for the particular functions of agencies; and

19 WHEREAS the legislature is particularly aware of the problem
20 since it has never had sufficient space for its work and recognizes
21 the plight of the many agencies which have been overcrowded for
22 years;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the legislative council is directed to
24 initiate a comprehensive study of the present and projected needs
25 of the state government for office and other space in cooperation
26 with other state agencies and make a detailed report with recom-
27 mendations to the legislature at the earliest possible date.
