HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 6

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to the appointment of
a separate director of insurance

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CONCURRING:

WHEREAS, one person is presently both the Director of Banking and Securities and the Director of Insurance; and

WHEREAS, Alaska is one of the few states in the Union without a separate Director of Insurance; and

WHEREAS, there are over 300 insurance companies licensed to practice in Alaska with such a large scope of activity that approximately \$42,000,000 in premium receipt income was earned by them in 1963; and

WHEREAS, the administration of such a specialized and complicated field should be the duty of a person who has been thoroughly trained and educated in both the theoretical and practical aspects of the insurance business;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor of Alaska is requested to urge the Commissioner of the Department of Commerce to appoint a separate Director of Insurance; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be sent to the Honorable William A. Egan, Governor of Alaska; and the Honorable E. N. Courtney, Commissioner of the Department of Commerce.
