5 Relating to a survey report of
6 vocational education programs
7 and facilities.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
9 CURRING:

10 WHEREAS the growing interest in vocational education programs
11 has been matched by the number of legislative bonding proposals
12 for the construction of vocational education schools or facili-
13 ties around the state; and

14 WHEREAS the Legislature shares the general public interest in
15 the subject but finds itself without meaningful information on
16 vocational education programs and plans, possibilities, and actual
17 needs; and

18 WHEREAS before the Legislature can legislate and appropriate
19 for programs and facilities it should have before it detailed
20 information on recent developments in the vocational education
21 field, their applicability to what Alaska has, needs and will
22 likely need, the cost of programs and facilities, the sources of
23 money for the programs and the amount available from each source,
24 and areas of priority need;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the information outlined in this resolu-
26 tion is required by the Legislature before it can act in the
27 public interest and it therefore directs the Legislative Council
28 to survey, study and report on all the facets of vocational
29 education outlined in this resolution. The findings and recom-
