HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18
IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
FOURTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

Relating to a study of the
taxation of oil and gas produc-
tion in Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
CURRING:

WHEREAS the production of oil and gas is a comparatively new
industry in the state and it is an industry of growing importance
to the development of our natural resources and economy; and

WHEREAS the nature and extent of the taxation of this indus-
try should be reviewed periodically to determine if the interest
of the state and the industry are being properly served; and

WHEREAS a review of the taxation of the oil and gas producing
industry in Alaska should be accompanied by an awareness of the
practices and conditions relating to the industry in other states;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
study and review the taxation of the oil and gas producing indus-
try in the state and report its findings and recommendations
along with comparative information on the taxation of that indus-
try in other states to the Legislature by the time of the conven-
ing of the second session of the Fourth Legislature in January
1966.
