5 Directing the Legislative Council to
6 make a comprehensive review of the
7 health, welfare, and labor laws of
8 the state.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE
10 CONCURRING:

11 WHEREAS the health, welfare, and labor laws of the state
12 represent a considerable body of law vital to the well-being of
13 the people of the state; and

14 WHEREAS since attaining statehood the legislature has made
15 progress in enacting substantive revisions of other areas of state
16 law to bring them into line with contemporary needs and circum-
17 stances; and

18 WHEREAS considerable portions of the state law on health,
19 welfare, and labor are in apparent need of review and revision to
20 give recognition to the needs of the people and the socio-
21 economic and constitutional developments of the past several
22 years;

23 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
24 examine the health, welfare, and labor laws of the state in the
25 light of experience with them and developments in those fields of
26 law in other states and at the federal level and report its find-
27 ings and recommendations to the legislature by January 1967.
