5 Directing a study of the employment
6 security laws and programs of the
7 state.
8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, THE SENATE CON-
9 CURRING:
10 WHEREAS the employment security laws and programs of the
11 state have been developed over the years on the basis of federal
12 laws and programs first established thirty years ago; and
13 WHEREAS each year the Legislature is involved with proposals
14 for piecemeal amendment of the employment security laws without
15 reference to an overall review of the applicability of the general
16 law and the federal regulations to the current needs of the state
17 and those affected by it; and
18 WHEREAS the Legislature would find a comprehensive review of
19 the employment security laws and programs useful in its delibera-
20 tions and consideration of related legislation;
21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council, with the full
22 cooperation of the Department of Labor, is directed to make a
23 comprehensive review of the employment security laws of the state
24 and to make recommendations to the Legislature for the improvement
25 of the law and include suggestions for change in the federal
26 program which the Legislature might wish to recommend to the
27 Congress.
