4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a study and report
6 on the state public and Forest
7 Service land program.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS, along with statehood, Congress granted to the State
10 of Alaska the right to select millions of acres of public and
11 Forest Service land; and

12 WHEREAS, in the selection of land of present or potential
13 value to the state, administrative and other obstacles have been
14 encountered which are little known or understood by the public;
15 and

16 WHEREAS the public has a continuing interest in and concern
17 with the acquisition, use, disposition, and availability of land
18 for homesites, agricultural and industrial uses, recreation and
19 other purposes; and

20 WHEREAS the amount and type of land in possession of the
21 state, its management, the income derived, types of leases and
22 contracts, the effect of aboriginal claims, and other aspects of
23 acquisition, control, and disposition are of continuing public
24 interest;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed,
26 with the cooperation of the Department of Natural Resources, to
27 make a full report to the Legislature in January of 1967 on all
28 facets of the public and Forest Service land program of the
29 state and to make recommendations regarding any state or federal
