5 Relating to dividing teacher
6 retirement benefits between the
7 state retirement system and the
8 social security system.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS Title 42 USC Sec. 418(d)(6)(C) was amended by Congress
11 in 1965 to permit teachers in Alaska to divide their retirement
12 system so as to take advantage of the existing state retirement
13 program and the federal social security system; and

14 WHEREAS the effect of this amendment is to provide the
15 teachers of Alaska an opportunity to decide by referendum whether
16 or not to have coverage under a divided retirement system; and

17 WHEREAS coverage for teachers under a divided retirement
18 system affords teachers certain benefits which they should have
19 an opportunity to elect to have; and

20 WHEREAS under the federal law the referendum may be initiated
21 by action of the governor or his designee;

22 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested
23 to provide for a referendum for the teachers in the state by
24 December 31, 1966, according to the applicable conditions specified
25 in Title 42 USC Sec. 418.
