1 IN THE HOUSE

2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 18

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting that the governor urge that
6 all interstate airlines voluntarily
7 apply to the Civil Aeronautics Board
8 for rate increases to provide funds for
9 centennial purposes.

10 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 WHEREAS, Alaska will celebrate the Purchase Centennial in
12 1967 in recognition of the 100th year of the purchase of Alaska
13 from Russia by the United States; and

14 WHEREAS, during the course of this year many new visitors
15 may be expected to visit Alaska and participate in this exposi-
16 tion; and

17 WHEREAS, Congressional appropriations are being sought asking
18 the federal government to participate by matching grants that
19 would encourage the economic development of Alaska; and

20 WHEREAS, due to the planning of many communities in the
21 state, it will be difficult for the State of Alaska to provide
22 the needed appropriations to assist the local programs to con-
23 struct facilities that would improve the economic stability of
24 the state; and

25 WHEREAS, due to the increased travel that will be generated
26 during 1967, preparations will have to be made as quickly as
27 possible so that Alaska will be ready to receive these guests;

28 BE IT RESOLVED that the governor be requested to ask that
29 interstate airlines now serving Alaska apply to the Civil

1 Aeronautics Board, voluntarily and in a fair and equal manner that
2 will not discriminate against any airline, asking that an addi-
3 tional \$2.50 per fare be added to tariffs now in effect, for
4 every incoming and outgoing passenger traveling to and from
5 Alaska; and be it

6 FURTHER RESOLVED that such additional proceeds be paid into
7 the general fund of the State of Alaska and that appropriations
8 for the purposes of the Alaska Purchase Centennial, through
9 regular legislative appropriation, shall not exceed the amount of
10 money collected by these additional fares collected; and be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED that such rate increases, if granted by the
12 Civil Aeronautics Board, would expire on December 31, 1968.

13 COPIES of this Resolution shall be sent to the Honorable
14 William A. Egan, Governor of the State of Alaska, the President
15 of Pacific Northern Airlines, the President of Pan American
16 Airlines, the President of Alaska Airlines, the President of
17 Northwest Orient Airlines, and the Civil Aeronautics Board.
