

1 IN THE HOUSE BY HAUGEN AND BOARDMAN
2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 21
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION
5 Requesting early action regarding
6 the planning for and construction
7 of the Stikine River access road
8 to Canada.

9 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 WHEREAS access to the Continental United States from South-
11 eastern Alaska by road has been a long-standing and long-recognized
12 need; and

13 WHEREAS there have been two major studies of the highway and
14 highway access problems of Alaska during the past 10 years, the
15 report of the International Rail and Highway Commission and the
16 "Highway Need Study Program"; and

17 WHEREAS both of these reports indicate the need for and
18 feasibility of an access road up the valley of the Stikine River
19 to connect with the Canadian road system;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to
21 apply all the energy and facilities of his office to accomplish
22 the necessary planning and other action for the early construction
23 of the access road up the valley of the Stikine River in order that
24 Southeastern Alaska can be connected with the highways leading to
25 the Continental United States.
