5 Relating to the leasing of
6 space from the Alaska State
7 Housing Authority.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the legislature by Chapter 99, Session Laws of
10 Alaska, 1965, provided for the construction and acquisition by the
11 Alaska State Housing Authority of public buildings for lease to
12 the state; and

13 WHEREAS a leasing program has been entered into under the
14 Act; and

15 WHEREAS AS 37.05.280 requires that any additional lease
16 executed after January 1, 1966, which provides for a payment in
17 excess of \$12,000 annually be approved by the legislature; and

18 WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state to enter
19 into the additional leases set out in this resolution;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that use of the space to be provided by
21 leases of the following premises and leases of said premises from
22 the Alaska State Housing Authority providing for payments in
23 excess of \$12,000 annually is approved:

24 The state court and office buildings at Sitka, Anchorage
25 and Fairbanks,

26 The highway department headquarters at Douglas,

27 The state police headquarters at Anchorage,

28 Employee housing at Angoon,

29 A one classroom addition at Ambler,

1 A one classroom addition at Stony River,
2 Employee housing at Manley Hot Springs,
3 A new jail facility at Juneau,
4 The Community Building located at 150 Third Street, Juneau,
5 Fish and Game headquarters building at Cold Bay,
6 Anchorage District Highway complex,
7 Ninilchik Highway Maintenance Shop, and
8 Bernice Lake Highway Maintenance Shop and Employee Housing.
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
