6 Babe Ruth World Series held in  
7 Fairbanks in 1967.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the youth of Alaska are our greatest natural resource;  
10 and

11 WHEREAS the activities of Babe Ruth Baseball, Inc. in Alaska  
12 have played a considerable role in developing our youth as  
13 citizens of the future; and

14 WHEREAS the Alaska Babe Ruth Baseball organization is attempt-  
15 ing to have the 1967 Babe Ruth World Series held at Fairbanks  
16 during Alaska's centennial year; and

17 WHEREAS the holding of this national event at Fairbanks  
18 during 1967 will enhance the observance of the Alaska Purchase  
19 Centennial and bring Alaska additional national recognition;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the legislature endorses the efforts of  
21 the State Babe Ruth Baseball organization and joins with it in  
22 inviting Babe Ruth Baseball, Inc. to hold the national Babe Ruth  
23 World Series in Fairbanks, Alaska in 1967.
