5 Requesting the Governor to make
6 certain general directions to the
7 Department of Education as to the
8 uses and places of use of money ap-
9 propriated to the department from
10 the 1966 School Construction and
11 Expansion Fund.

12 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 WHEREAS the legislature, in AS 14.16 has provided for a
14 system of regional high schools; and

15 WHEREAS the legislature, in AS 14.05.165 has required
16 establishment of a comprehensive curriculum in all high schools
17 of the state with 100 or more pupils and has authorized establish-
18 ment of a comprehensive curriculum in other schools; and

19 WHEREAS the legislature has provided for voter approval of
20 the issuance of the bonds necessary to implement and fund the
21 regional high schools and the comprehensive curriculum; and

22 WHEREAS the legislature in its collective wisdom wishes to
23 exercise its leadership in the field of education by indicating
24 its intent as to the general uses and places of use of the money
25 appropriated to the Department of Education from the 1966 School
26 Construction and Expansion Fund, while recognizing that the
27 specific uses and places of use of the money necessarily must be
28 flexible because of the limitations on data available to the
29 legislature;

1 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
2 Department of Education to utilize the sum of \$9,610,000 ap-
3 propriated to it from the 1966 School Construction and Expansion
4 Fund at the following locations, in the following approximate
5 amounts, and for the following purposes:
