5 Requesting the Governor to direct
6 the Department of Education to pro-
7 vide for the establishment of
8 regional high schools in accordance
9 with the directions of the legisla-
10 ture.

11 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 WHEREAS the legislature, in AS 14.16 has provided for a
13 system of regional high schools; and

14 WHEREAS the legislature has provided that a regional high
15 school shall be a school, offering to the pupils of a large sur-
16 rounding geographic region, a broad and comprehensive academic
17 and vocational education with a full complement of counseling and
18 guidance services and compensatory education, and affording
19 maximum opportunities for social and cultural transition, and that
20 regional high schools shall be established in connection with
21 existing facilities which are appropriately located, and shall be
22 complemented by dormitory facilities serving pupils from the
23 outlying portions of the region; and

24 WHEREAS the legislature, in implementing the plans for the
25 system, has selected

26 Anchorage,	Kodiak, and
27 Bethel,	Nome
28 Fairbanks,	

29 as having the requisite criteria for regional high schools; and

1 WHEREAS the legislature has by law given the Department of
2 Education the responsibility and authority necessary to implement
3 the establishment and to operate regional high schools; and

4 WHEREAS the legislature has provided for voter approval of
5 the issuance of the bonds necessary to establish these regional
6 high schools;

7 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is requested to direct the
8 Department of Education to immediately finalize the agreements
9 and to contract as necessary to provide for the establishment and
10 operation of the regional high schools.
