5 Requesting the designation of

6 Captain Cook State Park.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the State of Alaska has selected 5,120 acres at Point
9 Possession on Cook Inlet and the selection is now awaiting approval
10 of the Department of the Interior; and

11 WHEREAS the Cook Inlet Historical Society and others have
12 asked that the site be used for a state park to be known as the
13 Captain Cook State Park; and

14 WHEREAS the official designation of the park must await
15 federal approval of the land selection and some preliminary
16 planning;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to
18 direct the Division of Lands, Department of Natural Resources, to
19 take the necessary action as soon as feasible to see that the
20 necessary surveys and planning are accomplished preparatory to sub-
21 mitting legislation to the Legislature in January 1967 officially
22 designating the acreage set aside at Point Observation as the
23 Captain Cook State Park.
