2 HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 40

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting expeditious completion
6 of construction of the Anchorage-
7 Fairbanks Highway.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway is the most heavily
10 traveled highway in the state and serves the greatest number of
11 people; and

12 WHEREAS that portion of the Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway
13 passing through the Susitna Valley receives the heaviest traffic
14 in and out of the Anchorage metropolitan area; and

15 WHEREAS the entire Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway requires con-
16 siderable construction work and that portion which runs through
17 the Susitna Valley requires particular attention in order to
18 expedite the flow of personal and commercial traffic on it;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to
20 direct the Department of Highways to complete the construction on
21 the Anchorage-Fairbanks Highway with emphasis on the Susitna
22 Valley portion at the earliest possible time.
