IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

Requesting a study regarding the
regulation of the medical and allied
health laboratory professions.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS there has been a growing expression of need for the
enactment of legislation to regulate medical and allied health
laboratories and laboratory personnel; and

WHEREAS the Legislature believes that it is necessary to
acquire more information from those closely connected with the
medical laboratory field before attempting to legislate in this
area;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
study and determine whether there is a need for regulatory
legislation in the field of medical and allied health laboratory
professions, and to submit its findings and proposed legislation
to the Fifth Legislature in January, 1967.
