3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 FOURTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Directing the Legislative Council
6 to study and report on a records
7 management system for the state.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 WHEREAS the effectiveness of government is conditioned to a
10 great extent on the development, storage, use, accessibility, and
11 disposal of its records; and

12 WHEREAS a proper system of records management is essential to
13 the interests of all persons having dealings with the government to
14 protect their rights and to transact business; and

15 WHEREAS the development and maintenance of essential records
16 and the disposal of records no longer needed involves considerable
17 expense to the state government; and

18 WHEREAS the Legislature is vitally interested in the develop-
19 ment, maintenance, storage and disposition of state records as
20 essential functions of government;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is directed to
22 make a survey of record management practices in the state including
23 the use of microfilming, review management systems of other states,
24 and report its findings with recommendations to the Fifth Legisla-
25 ture in 1967 regarding a possible uniform system of records
26 management for the state.
