7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS legislation has been offered regarding the weight of
9 objects which employed women may be required or permitted to lift;
10 and

11 WHEREAS the health, safety and welfare of employees is of
12 continuing interest to the Legislature; and

13 WHEREAS the detailed implementation of employment safety laws
14 are best developed and executed under safety regulations promul-
15 gated by the state Department of Labor; and

16 WHEREAS the existing safety regulations of the Department of
17 Labor should be revised and improved periodically in order, among
18 other purposes, to protect female employees from being required
19 or permitted to lift objects of a weight injurious to their
20 safety, health and welfare;

21 BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature respectfully requests
22 the Commissioner of Labor to revise, up-date and improve the
23 Department of Labor General Safety Code.
